RECAP

Council has provisionally agreed that the space next to the Jubilee bench at The Denes will be the installation location.



The design has been approved. Quotation: £ 1,251.28



The panels will be made using plywood with planed hardwood door frames. Concerns were raised at the September Full Council meeting about the surface paint treatment proposed.

DECISIONS REQUIRED

- Formal approval of expenditure for box and installation (design and box expenditure approved in principle Sept 24)
- Approval of the new paint treatment and colour
- Agreement that the NMPC Library should be registered with Little Free Library).
- Approval of the side panel in Acrylic / Plexiglass and proposed wording
- Agree that the Working Group should work with the Clerk to design a new NMPC web page to explain the library box



• Agree that the Working Group should organise an opening ceremony, inviting Nash Mills School to participate.



CURRENT STATUS

INSTALLATION £250 + VAT

The Clerk has obtained installation permission from DBC and organised a quotation from an approved contractor.

The box will be installed two legs and on a platform in a similar format to that used at North Crawley.



PAINT TREATMENT AND COLOUR

The Working Group has reviewed the surface paint treatment options and consulted local suppliers. It now proposes ZINSSER ALLCOAT ® EXTERIOR SATIN matched to the green RAL colour 6005 to match the NMPC noticeboard at The Denes.
