CURRENT STATUS

INSTALLATION: The library box has been built and is ready to install. Installation was delayed due to the contractor's backlog caused by bad weather at the end of 2024. A firm installation date is awaited – anticipated to be in January.

LITTLE FREE LIBRARY: The library has been registered with Little Free Library and will be activated on their map once installed.

LAUNCH EVENT

The Working Group met to discuss a launch event and requests that Council approves these recommendations:

- Invite Nash Mills School to attend a launch event on World Book Day Thursday 6th March.
 - \circ In the event that the school cannot participate, then an event to be organised at the Denes on Saturday 8^{th} March.
- Order 50 World Book Day bookmarks including the NMPC logo so that one can be given to each pupil attending with some spares to give away at The Denes monthly session on 8th March. Total cost £81 incl VAT. (Colour black, image "D" pile of books)
