As the parish has ongoing issues related to dog waste, would NMPC like to take this opportunity to attend the show (and perhaps run a small competition / side show) to engage with local dog owners? Alternatively, if council does not wish to attend, would NMPC like to provide ‘NMPC’ branded giveaways including dog waste bags promoting responsibly dog ownership.
