

REPORT TO NMPC MARCH 2025

VE DAY Event 8th May 2025



An event has been registered on the official site which triggered this response: “We are delighted you are taking part in VE Day 80 on 8th May and have great pleasure in attaching your Certificate for doing so, enabling you to download, print and frame them should you so wish. We will be contacting you again during the latter part of April, and in the meantime, wish you all well with your planning for this historical occasion.” The certificate was reproduced in the parish magazine. However, Nash Mills is not showing on the online map, so Councillor Briggs / the Clerk will pursue its addition.

The Three Tuns pub has agreed to a co-hosted quiz night on the evening of Thursday 8th May.

There will be no cost to NMPC. Attendees will be charged £8.50 which will include the quiz prize fund and a meal of fish goujons and chips to be served in newspaper style boxes. The meal is in line with official guidance – fish and chips were not rationed during the war.

Councillor Briggs has been asked to write the quiz with VE Day themes.

Pre-booking direct with the Three Tuns will be required.

A “save the date” event has been mentioned in the current parish magazine. Nearer the time it will be promoted via both the Three Tuns and NMPC social media.

Local Residents Associations will also be contacted directly to promote the event.
